4. Season 12 action points review

Suspensions for red cards

- After the length of suspension/ban is decided only serious incidents (Serious violent conduct etc) can be taken to the panel for an appeal.

Only used the panel once last year so this process will continue next season and beyond.

Conduct towards referees:

- Players who constantly argue/shout at the referee are more likely to be booked. Warnings were sent out to Captains in January of Season 11
- Violent conduct towards referees is strictly prohibited. TML will not stand for poor behaviour towards match officials.
- Referee meeting: Will be discussing with the referees about punishments when a player directly insults a referee using very bad language.

Rude language directed towards referees will be discussed at the referee meeting. Mail to be sent out to Captains before the season so players can be warned.

Communication on match days:

- Please make me aware if you are away on a certain match day and who will be in charge.
- Rain on match day procedure: Wait for my email or phone call / Make sure your players do not contact me / Call to be made early as possible. Within 3 hours of KO.

Improved throughout the season. Please remember: If you are away on a match day weekend then please let me know who will be the Club's point of contact.

5. Season 13 Discussion Points

YC&AC will start TML13 in Division 3.

- New team. Old & Young YC&AC members.
- Note: Teams cannot do this in future seasons. Special compensation to YC&AC (Club decision/Own ground)

To stress: This is a one off. Teams will not be able to fold and then be allowed to join in a lower division.

Cup First Round:

- All Division 1 teams to be seeded.

This will start from Season 13. This should make both the Cup competitions more competitive.

Review of rules:

- Registrations: ID's to be sent when fully registering a player (Shibuya, Shinagawa, Suganami Ku, Bunkyo)
Need ID's for every registered player! Photo of the front and back of Residence card/ Driving license
- Scheduling: Teams can ask for 3 weekends off per half a season. Please stay on top of this.
- League system: Top two will be promoted / Bottom two relegated .This may not be the case when a team folds and a new team enters.
- Squad size: 16 players only.
- Forfeiting matches: Cancel early not at the pitch!

Forfeiting on the day is not acceptable.

New Rules/ Procedure:

- Players may not play for another team in the same division without prior transfer approval. Without transfer approval then the following sanctions will take place: Team deducted a point and awarded a 3-0 loss / Player is banned for 1 match. During this time a transfer can take place.

When registering a player from another TML team please let me know which team he already plays for.

- Referees will take photos of players booked or sent off after the match. (Team photo before/ Individual) To be thought about more throughout the summer!

Suspensions:

- Will be bringing some incidents down to a 2 match ban. Pushing incidents / Light kick outs.

This is to help players who lose their heads in the heat of the moment.

Current rules:

3 match ban minimum for the following

Guilty of Serious Foul Play: Using excessive force with the clear intention to hurt an opponent during a challenge. Examples would be – two footed tackle, playing over the ball, tackle from behind etc. If this is deemed to be dangerous.

Guilty of Violent Conduct: punching, hitting, striking, kicking, elbow etc.

Website:

- Site is being designed as we speak. Will function best if all teams try and contribute to the site. match reports/ Team pages updated.

Kit:

- Some teams need improving, Numbered shirts are a must.
- No trousers to be worn in matches.

Please make sure all players are well presented in matching uniforms.

Grounds:

- KUIS: Possible Sala home pitch. Div2 players addresses
- Shigaku: Shiritsu gakko(u) kyo(u)shokuin kyo(u)sai kanyu-sha-hyo(u) - 私立学校教職員共済加入者証
- YC&AC: Important to KO on time. Make your team aware that they need to arrive early and be ready to KO on time.
- Pitch conduct: No pets, smoking or drinking of beer on all pitches
- Redsland: New surface.
